


MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

The Keypad must be mounted in sight of the Door(s), at least 5 feet above the ground and dear of any moving

- Mount Keypad (Mounting screws located inside Battery Compartment.)
- Remove Battery Cover (See Figure 3).
- Install a screw into the drilled hole, leaving a 1/8" gap between the screw head and the wall. (See Figure 2.) Drill a 1/16" pilot hole for the top mounting screw. Figure 2
- Hook the Keypad over the screw
- Mark and drill pilot hole and fasten bottom screw.
